Dear Ms. Hammond:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration (FTA) received the December 11, 2008 letter along with the 2009-2012 STIP from Ms. Stephanie Tax requesting approval.

Planning Finding: Based on the State DOT and MPOs self-certifications of their statewide and metropolitan transportation planning processes, review of self-certification supporting documentation, Federal certification of TMAs within the State, and our involvement in the State and MPO transportation planning processes, the FHWA and FTA hereby find that the transportation planning process substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C. Sections 134 and 135 and 49 U.S.C. Sections 5303-5305.

Approval: Based on our review of the 2009-2012 STIP, the FHWA and FTA hereby find that the projects in the 2009-2012 STIP are based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 Sections 134 and 135 and 49 U.S.C. Sections 5303-5305. Therefore, the 2009-2012 STIP submitted by Ms. Tax is approved.
