I-5 to Medina: Bridge Replacement and HOV Project

## Crews to begin preparing for in-water bridge pier in Lake Washington

### *Around the clock work will begin September 17 and last up to 2 weeks*

WSDOT and its contractor, Kiewit/General/Manson, a Joint Venture (KGM), will begin preparing for the installation of a bridge pier located about 250 feet from shore in Lake Washington, just north of the existing bridge in Medina. Crews will work around the clock beginning Monday, Sept. 17, at 7 a.m. until Saturday, Sept. 22, at 11:59 p.m. to prepare the lake bed for pier installation.

If needed, crews may also work the following week using the same Monday through Saturday around the clock schedule to complete the work. The impact of the work is expected to be minimal though residents in Medina near the Lake Washington in-water construction site may see lights and hear crane noise and tug boat engines. Crews will dredge the lakebed and prepare it for cofferdam installation. A cofferdam is used to create a dry work zone for construction of the bridge pier foundation. WSDOT and KGM will use best management practices to minimize noise and will keep lights directed towards the work zone.
