We want your input to help improve the safety and reliability of State Route 164 (SR 164) and State Route 169 (SR 169)!

You are invited to attend four upcoming open houses in Auburn, Enumclaw, Maple Valley, and on the Muckleshoot Reservation. We are seeking comments from the public on key transportation issues and potential solutions concerning these corridors.

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and local jurisdictions along SR 164 and SR 169 are cooperating to produce Route Development Plans (RDP) for each corridor. We will incorporate public input, review each route, and identify transportation solutions to improve safety and travel mobility along the highway. The identified improvements and the final RDP's will guide short- and long-term projects for both routes. The studies will be completed by early 2006.
