I-5 to Medina: Bridge Replacement and HOV Project

New nighttime construction work begins April 25

Start of decommissioning activities

Beginning as early as Monday, April 25 and continuing through the end of the 2016 Kiewit/General/Manson, a Joint Venture (KGM) will complete decommissioning work to remove the old SR 520 floating bridge from Lake Washington. The pontoons have been sold and will be removed from Lake Washington through the Hiram M. Chittenden Locks in Ballard. The majority of the remaining components will be dismantled onsite and hauled to concrete recycling facilities, where most of the materials will be processed for reuse as dry aggregate for other paving projects. Reminder: SR 520 closed April 22 - 25

WSDOT and its contractor KGM, are preparing to complete a second weekend closure this month to switch eastbound traffic onto the new SR 520 floating bridge. Once complete, traffic in both directions will be on the new bridge. Closure details: 11 p.m. Friday, April 22 to 5 a.m. Monday, April 25.

During this closure, crews will pave and stripe the roadway, place barrier and continue roadway grinding work on the west side of the new bridge. Nearby residents may hear a loud, consistent noise similar to an industrial fan. Crews will utilize construction best practices to limit noise levels, when possible.
