

Construct New Bridge



SR 124 Monument Railroad Crossing

Purpose

WSDOT will construct a bridge over the Union Pacific railroad crossing to allow SR 124 traffic to cross above the railroad. Monument Drive will reconnect to SR 124 west of its current location. Moving the intersection will improve safety for traffic entering SR 124.

By removing the intersection at the railroad, this project eliminates collisions between vehicles and trains.

Project Benefits

- Eliminates collisions between trains and vehicles
- Improves safety by elevating the highway above the railroad
- Reduces delays

Funding

Total: \$8.2 million

Estimate includes engineering, right of way and construction costs.

Project Timeline

This project is in design. Construction is scheduled to start in 2016 and be complete in 2017.
