Weather postpones I-5 lane closures in south Seattle for Sound Transit's light rail project



Due to forecasts for snow, wind and hail overnight, we have canceled all scheduled lane closures for construction projects for Tuesday night. As a result, there will be no Sound Transit construction work tonight over the southbound lanes of I-5 at Boeing Access Road.

If weather conditions permit, work may resume tomorrow on the Link light rail overpass over I-5. If work resumes tomorrow night, it should be on the following schedule:

On Wednesday, Jan. 10 and Thursday, Jan. 11, three southbound lanes of I-5 will be closed overnight at Boeing Access Road. The first lane will close at 8 p.m., the second at approx. 11 p.m., and the third lane will close at midnight, if it is needed. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m. the following morning. There will be no lane closures on Friday, Jan. 12.
