Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

Crews to construct a work bridge on wetland mitigation site

Work begins Aug. 27 and lasts through September

WSDOT and its contractor, Goodfellow Brothers, Inc., will begin construction work at a property near this location. Crews will install eight piles for the abutment of a work bridge. The work bridge will serve as an access point for wetland restoration work to be completed in spring 2014. When complete, this area will support a variety of wetland plants and wildlife. Evans Creek and Bear Creek, which both flow through the property, provide habitat for Chinook salmon and other important species.

Crews plan to work Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to complete the work. Additional days may be worked if necessary to ensure the bridge is complete by the end of September 2012. Neighbors may observe equipment on the south end of the site near NE 84th Street and NE Union Hill Road, including a crane and pile driver and the work bridge under construction. Residents may hear noise from the crane, pile driver, generators, and power and vibratory equipment. WSDOT and Goodfellow Brothers will ensure this work does not exceed allowable decibel levels.
