# SR 519 Intermodal Access Project

**You are invited to attend a construction kick-off ceremony  
for the final phase of SR 519 construction**

Please join WSDOT Secretary Paula Hammond and the State Route 519 design-build project team to celebrate the kick-off of the final phase of construction for the SR 519 Intermodal Access Project.

Upon completion in 2010, this project will improve traffic flow and pedestrian and bicyclist safety by improving connections between I-90, I-5 and the Seattle waterfront and separating people, traffic and rail. SR 519 Phase 2 will be completed prior to major construction of the south end of the viaduct so that freight and people have safer and more efficient options to get in and out of the SODO area.

As part of this project, crews will:

- Improve the intersection of S. Atlantic Street and First Avenue S.
- Build a westbound off-ramp from I-90 and I-5 that connects to the existing S. Atlantic Street (Edgar Martinez Drive S.) overpass so vehicles can cross over the railroad tracks and avoid train delays.
- Build a bridge to separate pedestrians and bicyclists from rail traffic at S. Royal Brougham Way.

The new and improved roadways will benefit all travel modes, from freight vehicles bound for the Port of Seattle's terminals, to sports and event fans heading to the stadiums, to ferry riders going to Colman Dock.
