

ALLOWABLE SALT WATER WORK WINDOWS

Work may occur year around expect for the Tidal Reference Areas (TRA) and dates as listed below. Work below the ordinary high water line within the TRA and dates listed below may be acceptable if a WDFW representative confirms a lack of spawn during a site inspection. Arrangements for a site inspection shall be made with the Area Habitat Biologist. Work shall commence within 48 hours of notification by WDFW and shall be completed within seven days of project commencement:

TRA 2: From July 1 through December 31 and January 1 through March 31 of any year.

TRA 3: From October 1 through December 31 and January 1 through April 30 of any year.

TRA 4: From October 1 through December 31 and January 1 through April 14 of any year.

TRA 5 (except Eagle Harbor and Sinclair Inlet as noted below): From September 1 through December 31 and January 1 through March 31 of any year.

Eagle Harbor and Sinclair Inlet: Work below the ordinary high water line during any period of any year.

TRA 7 –9: Work below the ordinary high water line during any period of any year.

For the specific locations or Tidal Reference Areas (TRA) and dates as listed below work below the ordinary high water line shall not occur for the protection of surf smelt spawning beds:

Twin Rivers: From May 1 through August 31 of any year.

Deep Creek: From May 1 through August 31 of any year.

Dungeness Bay: From October 15 through December 31 and from January 1 through January 14 of any year.

Kilisut Harbor: Work below the ordinary high water line shall not occur from September 15 through October 31 of any year.

TRA 11: From September 15 through December 31 and from January 1 through March 1 of any year.

TRA 13: From October 15 through December 31 and from January 1 through January 31 of any year.

TRA 14: From May 15 through September 14 of any year
