ALTERNATE ROUTES

Winter Driving Conditions on Passes

Drivers should carry chains and be prepared for winter conditions across the mountains and in Eastern Washington. This includes compact snow and ice on all mountain pass highways.

I-90 Snoqualmie pass: Closed both directions from North Bend to Ellensburg due to avalanche danger, check web site for more details: <http://www.wsdot.wa.gov/traffic/passes/snoqualmie/>

Traveling toward Western Washington: Use the following route: exit I-90 at Ellensburg and follow I-82 to the junction of I-82/I-84, then west on I-84 to the junction with I-5 in Portland. Then head north on I-5 into Western Washington.

Traveling toward Eastern Washington: Use the following route: take I-5 south to Portland, then go east on I-84 to the junction of I-84/I-82, then east to I-90 at Ellensburg. Take I-90 east into Eastern Washington.
