



I-405 - NE 10th Street Bridge Project

Nighttime Lane and Ramp Closures in Bellevue Nov. 10-25

Overview

Beginning the evening of Nov. 10, crews will close lanes and ramps on I-405 in downtown Bellevue to set girders for the new NE 10th Street Bridge. Drivers can expect short delays between midnight and 5 a.m. as traffic is reduced to one lane in Bellevue. The lane and ramp closures are necessary so crews can safely place 24 girders for the new bridge.

Work will take place:

- Nov. 10-25 on weeknights
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Ramps may close at 9 p.m. on the following dates:

Nov. 10, 12, 14, 21

- The southbound I-405 off-ramp to NE Sixth Street.
- The NE Sixth Street on-ramp to northbound I-405.
- The southbound I-405 off-ramp to NE Fourth Street.
- The NE Eighth Street on-ramp to northbound I-405.

Nov. 11, 13, 17, 24

- The southbound I-405 off-ramps to NE Eighth Street.

Nov. 18, 19, 20, 25

- The NE Eighth Street on-ramps to northbound I-405.
- The NE Fourth Street on-ramp to northbound I-405.
