Recap of 11-10-11 Stakeholder Meeting and updates of WSDOT's and other agencies' on-going planning activities:

- Richard Warren gave a brief recap of the 11-10-11 Stakeholders' Meeting
- Don Cairns, city of Redmond reviewed the status of the city's Transportation Master Plan Update. An open house was held November 17th to solicit public input and comment. Don noted there are 181 identified projects, 84 of them within ¼ mile of SR 520; and that there are \$800 million in needed improvements. The plan is expected to go to the city council March 2012 for review and approval.
- Kim Becklund and Rick Logwood, city of Bellevue, reviewed Bellevue's updates to the downtown plan and transit plan. The plans include non-motorized trail investments, the SR 520 regional trail, Bel-Red Road improvements.
- Joint Transportation Committee – SR 520, I-90 and I-405 tour. Kim Becklund, Greg Johnson provided overview of the panel discussion and tour that was held for the JTC on November 16th. It was noted that Greg Johnson and Jim Stanton were part of the panel that presented information to the JTC (see attached PowerPoint presentation.) The SR 520 Multi-modal corridor study was discussed.
- Russ East, WSDOT, gave an update on "Moving Washington." Russ stated the update parallels the Governor's "Connecting Washington Task Force" efforts; and will strategize investments and emphasize efficient operations of the road system and manage demand.
- Mike Groesch gave an update on the results of the Governor's "Connecting Washington Task Force." Mike stated it is expected the Governor will present her package of proposed transportation improvements in January.

- Richard Warren gave a brief review of the safety analysis completed to date. The analysis shows that within the period studied (2005-2010) and there were 9 collisions and one fatality along the study corridor. The initial analysis also indicates speeding and DUI were factors in almost all the collisions. Further coordination with WSDOT HQ to finalize the data will occur over the coming months.

Project Identification Map and List:

Richard Warren distributed to the stakeholders' a map and list of transportation needs and deficiencies that were identified at the November Stakeholders' meeting. It was noted that the majority of the deficiencies were non-motorized. The Stakeholders agreed that the map and list were accurate (see attachments.)

Develop Conceptual Solution Alternatives:

After reviewing the map and list, noted above; the Stakeholders suggested workshops be held in January that would focus on specific issues identified on the map and lists. The intent of the workshops is to focus on generating a preliminary project list for the 2012 legislative session.

The workshops would last about one half of a day and involve various staff and Stakeholders.

The four specific items to be covered by the workshops are:

- regional trails
- pedestrian and non-motorized improvements at 41st and 50th
- operations at the east end of the corridor
- westbound SR 520 to southbound I-405 improvement(s)

Performance Measures:

A draft list of performance measures was distributed to the stakeholders for review and comment (see attached.) Discussion centered on how the measures would be used to phase and sequence recommended improvements; overall operations of the corridor; how the measures would also help rank priorities along the corridor.
