

NOTICE: Expect work day and night along SR 520 and 92nd Avenue Northeast area *- Prepare for traffic shift this spring*


Construction is well underway all along the SR 520 corridor with work occurring almost around the clock. Area residents will see the construction of retaining and rockery walls on both sides of SR 520 east of 92nd Avenue Northeast and the continuation of overpass work on the 92nd Avenue Northeast lid structure.

Clyde Hill and Yarrow Point residents near SR 520 and 92nd Avenue Northeast should expect to see and hear:

- Construction of retaining and rockery walls east of 92nd Avenue Northeast, both north and south of SR 520. This work will involve earth-moving equipment, concrete trucks, drilling equipment and the delivery of materials needed to construct the walls.
- Overnight work on the 92nd Avenue Northeast lid over SR 520. Diaphragm construction to link the bridge girders together is already underway and will continue into March. This work is being done over live traffic so nightly lane closures are required.
- Traffic on 92nd Avenue Northeast is currently scheduled to shift onto the new west section of the lid in mid-April, followed by the demolition of the existing 92nd Avenue Northeast bridge during a full closure of the highway later this spring.
- All this work is scheduled to occur mostly during the daytime. However some nighttime work will be required. Residents should expect to hear the sounds of trucks, bulldozers, excavators, back up alarms and light generators.




Illustration of the north side rockery with landscaping. Barrier and homes at top of wall not shown.
