




The US Highway 12 Coalition has formed an alliance of public and private organizations working to four-lane US Highway 12 from Burbank to Walla Walla.



Add Lanes, Four-laning US Highway 12 (Phase 6)



Why is WSDOT four-laning US 12?

This project is part of a corridor plan to construct US 12 as a four-lane highway from Burbank to the city of Walla Walla. This project will improve safety, decrease congestion, and enhance economic vitality.

Project Description

This section of US 12 was relocated and constructed as a four-lane divided highway. WSDOT and the contractor constructed approximately eight miles of new highway, four new intersections, and an interchange at Pine Street.

Project Benefits


The new four-lane divided highway will enhance safety and decrease congestion. This project limits cross traffic by reducing the number of intersections and private driveways, and provides new intersections at Frenchtown Road, Last Chance Road, and Sudbury Road. An interim intersection near McDonald Road connects the new route to the existing US 12. The interchange at Pine Street will reduce congestion, improve traffic mobility, and encourage economic development.

Scheduled Start: Spring 2008
 Scheduled Completion: Summer 2010

Project Cost Estimate


Estimated Total Project Cost \$56.0 million
 Note: This estimate includes engineering, right of way, and construction costs.




New intersection at Frenchtown Road
