# Phases 7 & 8: Wallula to Walla Walla Corridor Study

## What is the purpose of this study?

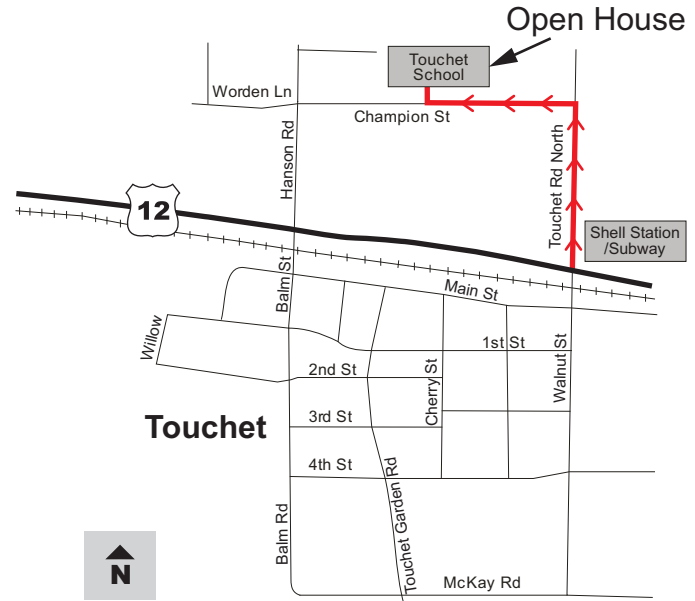
The Wallula to Walla Walla Corridor Study will develop recommendations for the location of an improved four-lane divided highway between Wallula and Walla Walla.

## What has been done so far?

A footprint study has been completed for the section of US 12 between the US 12/SR 730 intersection and Walla Walla. The Study recommended a new highway be constructed north of the existing US 12 highway based on the following criteria:

- Environmental impacts
- Right of way and access changes
- Accident history and traffic analysis
- Engineering feasibility
