Local agency personnel involved with maintenance of streets, roads, and highways. This class will be a combination of WSDOT and Local Agency Maintenance technicians.

Course Description

This workshop, will address areas of basic safety for employees who are new to public works maintenance work.

- ❖ Hazardous Material Awareness,
- ❖ Endangered Species Act and Best Management Practices to accomplish work in and near habitat,
- ❖ Hazard Tree Assessment,
- ❖ Chain Saw Safety,
- ❖ Spill Kit Training,
- ❖ Equipment Operations - tie downs and trailer,
- ❖ Hazard Assessment for Callouts,
- ❖ Proper Records,
- ❖ Ever safe Driving.

The purpose of this training is to acquaint **newly** employed maintenance personnel with safety and environmental best management practices in their everyday work activities.

NOTE: Personal safety equipment is required and students need to bring their own hearing protection, safety glasses, hard hat, safety vest, work boots, gloves, and rain gear.

Approximately half the class time will be outside at the GT 18 maintenance site just off Interstate 90 east of Montlake Park. No food or overnight accommodations are included in the cost and are the responsibility of the individual or their agency.
