Installation Instructions

Welcome to Good To Go!

Good To Go![™] electronic tolling is the fastest way to save money on all toll roads in the state of Washington.

Auto replenishment is the best way to ensure your **Good To Go!** account never runs out of money. It's easy to set up your **Good To Go!** account so that your bank account or credit card is automatically charged with a preset replenishment amount when your account balance gets low. You will receive a monthly email with a link to your account statement, and can check your most recent account activity online or by phone at any time. With auto replenishment you're always **Good To Go!**

1 Clean:

Clean and dry the inside of the windshield with rubbing alcohol or windshield cleaner.

2 Position:

Position your **Good To Go!**[™] Switchable Pass with On/Off Option on the inside of the front windshield under the rearview mirror as shown in the illustration. The pass should be placed below any metalized sun strips or visor tints. The top of your pass should be no more than 5" below the roofline of the vehicle. If you choose to place the pass behind your rearview mirror it must be at least 2" below the mirror stem.

3 Stick:

Before separating the pass from the Velcro[®], peel off the protective backing from the Velcro and place the pass in the region indicated in the illustration with the slider facing down. To ensure a tight seal, use your thumb to firmly press each side of the pass against the windshield for 15 seconds. Once secured you can remove the pass and the Velcro backing will remain on your windshield.

4 On or Off:


Keep your pass in the "on" position at all times to ensure proper function, unless you are using the HOT Lanes. If you are using the HOT Lanes with carpool status, simply pull the slider down to the "off" position. If you use the HOT Lanes as a solo driver, keep the pass in the "on" position.

NOTE: The windshield on a small number of vehicles are metalized throughout and will need a different type of pass. If you have this type of windshield, contact the Customer Service Center: 1-866-936-8246.

Mounting in Multiple Vehicles

Additional Velcro backings for sharing the pass among multiple vehicles are available through the Customer Service Center.

Detach the pass from the windshield of vehicle A. Attach your additional Velcro backing to the strip of Velcro that is already adhered to the pass. Then attach the pass to the windshield of vehicle B following the directions in steps 2 and 3.


Good To Go! Switchable Pass with On/Off Option


IMPORTANT: This pass must be mounted on the inside of the FRONT windshield.



1 Clean





2 Position




NOTE: Place pass below any metalized strips. If you have a windshield that is metalized throughout, contact the Customer Service Center: 1-866-936-8246.


3 Stick



4 On or Off:



Keep your pass in the "on" position at all times unless you are using the SR 167 HOT Lanes with carpool status.



Mounting in Multiple Vehicles

Additional Velcro backings for sharing the Switchable Pass among multiple vehicles are available through the Customer Service Center. Simply detach the pass from the windshield of vehicle A and install in vehicle B following the directions in steps 2 and 3.
