ORDINANCE NO. 309

AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Elmer City providing for highway access management, access permits and administrative process pursuant to RCW 47.50.

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it necessary to provide regulation and control of vehicular access and connection points of ingress to, and egress from, the state highway system within the incorporated areas of the Town of Elmer City,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Elmer City does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 47.50 RCW is hereby adopted by reference to provide for the regulation and control of vehicular access and connection points of ingress to, and egress from, the state highway system within the incorporated area of the Town of Elmer City.

Section 2. Pursuant to the requirements and authority of Chapter 47.50 RCW, there is hereby adopted by reference the provisions of Chapter 468-51 and Chapter 468-52 of the Washington Administrative Code, together with all future amendments, in order to implement the requirements of Chapter 47.50 RCW.

Section 3. Definitions. For purposes of this ordinance, and the regulations adopted by reference, the term "government entity" means the Town of Elmer City. Where there is any reference to "the department" in the administrative and procedural sections adopted by reference, that reference shall be deemed to mean the Town for purposes of this ordinance.

Section 4. Fees. All fees due and payable in connection with access permitting shall be paid to the Town.
