

Notice: Construction to begin on NE 124th Street overpass in Kirkland night of August 14

As part of the I-405 Bellevue to Lynnwood Widening and Express Toll Lanes project, WSDOT and its contractor, Flatiron Constructors, will complete a number of improvements to the NE 124th Street overpass in Kirkland this summer and fall. Work on the overpass is scheduled to begin as early as Wednesday, August 14 and will take approximately three months to complete.

Project improvements

Improvements to the NE 124th Street overpass include:

- Installing new sidewalk, handrail and bridge railing for traffic and pedestrian safety.
- Grinding the roadway and placing new asphalt pavement for a smoother driving surface.
- Removing existing manholes on the bridge deck.

Work hours

Work will occur during daytime and nighttime hours, Monday through Friday. Some weekend work may also be required.

Traffic and pedestrian details

During this work, traffic on the NE 124th Street overpass will be reduced from five lanes to four lanes. An additional lane will also be intermittently closed to accommodate specific pieces of work or construction equipment.

Full closures of the overpass at night (10 p.m. to 5 a.m.) may be required during work zone installation and paving activities. Drivers should expect congestion through the area, and follow the directions of signs and flaggers.

Pedestrian detours will be in place to move people safely through the work zone.

Other anticipated impacts

Drivers and residents can expect noise, dust and vibration from construction equipment, such as back-up alarms used for safety, concrete breakers and engine sounds.
