Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

Fish culvert installation requires closure of northbound 112th Avenue Northeast for 2 months

Both directions closed during nighttime and weekend-long closures

Beginning Monday, July 8, crews begin work on a new fish-friendly culvert that crosses under 112th Avenue Northeast and SR 520. In order to complete this critical work, 112th Avenue Northeast will be temporarily redesignated for southbound traffic only. A signed detour will direct northbound drivers to Bellevue Way via Northeast 12th Street. In late August, crews will restore 112th Avenue Northeast to its original configuration.


Key details:

- Northbound 112th Avenue Northeast closed between SR 520 and Northeast 12th Street until late August.
- Both directions of 112th Avenue Northeast will be closed at night and during some weekends.
- **Business Access:** Access will be maintained throughout the duration of the construction.

Overnight and full weekend closure dates:

- July 12 – July 15 Weekend: Crews will completely close 112th Avenue Northeast between 7 p.m. Friday and 6 a.m. Monday for equipment and material mobilization.
- July 15 – July 19 Nightly: Crews will close 112th Avenue Northeast nightly between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. to relocate utilities and install the fish-friendly culvert.
- July 19 – July 22 Weekend: Crews will completely close 112th Avenue Northeast between 7 p.m. Friday and 6 a.m. Monday to relocate utilities and install the culvert.
- Aug. 23 – Aug. 26 Weekend: Crews will completely close 112th Avenue Northeast between 7 p.m. Friday and 6 a.m. Monday to backfill the culvert, reinstall utilities, and restore the roadway.

This work is weather dependent and in the event of a major storm and work delay, additional notification will be provided.

Suggested detour routes during northbound 112th Avenue Northeast closure

— Road closure


112th Avenue Northeast northbound lane closure between the eastbound on-ramp to SR 520 and Northeast 24th Street

— Suggested bicycle detour

For northbound bicycle travel from Bellevue use Northeast 12th Street to 116th Avenue Northeast to Northrup Way. Southbound bicycle travel can use the detour or 112th Avenue Northeast.

— Suggested vehicle detour

Signed vehicle detour route via Bellevue Way
