ORDINANCE 2177

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE AMENDING TITLE 12 OF THE
SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE CREATING NEW
CHAPTER 12.11 ADOPTING CERTAIN STATE
STANDARDS – DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
ACCESS PERMITTING STANDARDS**

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Washington has adopted legislation requiring cities and towns within the State of Washington to adopt access permitting standards for managing access on state highways within their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, RCW 47.50.030(3) requires cities and towns to adopt access permitting standards that meet or exceed the access standards of the State of Washington, found at Chapters 468-51 and 52 of the Washington Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that Title 12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code should be amended to add new Chapter 12.11 adopting by reference the access permitting standards of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that such amendment is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Title 12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code is hereby amended to add new Chapter 12.11 which shall read as follows:

Adoption of State Standards

Section 12.11.010 Adoption by Reference – Access Permitting Standards – State Highways

12.11.010 Adoption by Reference – Access Permitting Standards – State Highways. The provisions of Chapters 468-51 and 52 of the Washington Administrative Code, as now existing or hereafter amended, pertaining to access permitting standards for access onto and from state highways lying within the City of Sunnyside, are hereby adopted by reference.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Title 12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after passage, approval and publication as required by law, and the City Manager is authorized to communicate this adoption to all agencies with jurisdiction.
