You're invited to a neighborhood open house: **I-405/SR 167 Interchange Direct Connector Project**

Dear neighbor,

As you may know, the Washington State Department of Transportation is moving forward with the design and environmental work for the new I-405/SR 167 Interchange Direct Connector. This project will address traffic challenges at one of the state's most congested areas.

Whether you joined us at last summer's open house or are new to the project, we hope you'll join us for our next event, where we'll provide an update about the next steps for this project. There is no formal program, so feel free to drop in any time that works for you.

About this project

WSDOT plans to build a new flyover ramp connecting the SR 167 HOT lanes with the I-405 carpool lanes in Renton. This new ramp will improve traffic flow and safety at this heavily traveled interchange (*see visualization at right*).

WSDOT has not yet received construction funding for this work and would not break ground until at least 2015. However, we are currently starting with preliminary engineering and purchasing property to build the project.
