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
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WSDOT and contractor Wilder Construction will be closing State Route 9 at 233rd Place SE from 10 p.m. on Friday, June 23 to 5 a.m. on Monday, June 26, in order to complete a local sewer improvement project.

During the closure, traffic will follow a signed detour route using SR 522 and SR 524 (Maltby Road). Drivers should expect delays and plan accordingly.

The contractor will install a 166-foot-long section of local sewer line under the roadway. King County's Wastewater Treatment Division is funding the project, which is needed to increase capacity in an existing sewer line. WSDOT is managing the installation of the sewer line because it is taking place within WSDOT's SR 9 Widening project limits.

This work must be completed now so crews will not have to dig up the newly widened lanes at a later date.
