- Purpose:** The purpose of the Washington Transportation Plan (WTP) is to:
- Establish a 20-year vision for the development of the statewide transportation system
 - Identify the total unfunded statewide need over 20 years
 - Identify significant statewide transportation issues
 - Recommend statewide transportation policies and strategies to the legislature and Governor (*RCW 47.01.071(4)*)

WTP Plan Requirements from RCW 47.01.071:

- Comprehensive and balanced statewide transportation plan
- Consistent with state's growth management goals
- Based on transportation policy goals of RCW 47.04.280 (the five goals)
- Reflect priorities of government
- Address regional needs, including multimodal transportation planning
- Establish a vision for development of the statewide system
- Identify significant transportation policy issues
- Recommend policies and strategies that:
 - Will meet the needs of the people of the state for safe and efficient transportation services
 - Provide for integrated, intermodal systems
 - Define the role of the state, regional, and local governments in determining transportation policies, transportation planning, and in implementing the state transportation plan
 - Integrate the statewide transportation plan with the needs of the elderly and persons with disabilities

Draft 2030 Vision, developed by WTP Team:
