Dear Property Owner, Business or Resident:

The SR 519 team is moving forward with pre-construction activities to refine the SR 519 project design. Intermittently over the next six weeks, crews working for WSDOT will be verifying the location of underground utilities, including water, power, gas and phone. Confirming the lines' exact locations will help to eliminate the possibility of hitting a utility during construction and disrupting service. Crews will analyze utility locations on First Avenue South and South Atlantic Street and South Royal Brougham Way.

What You Can Expect

On Thursday, April 10 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., crews will drill six or seven holes in the sidewalk on First Avenue South, just south of South Atlantic Street. The sidewalk will be partially blocked, but pedestrians will still be able to safely travel alongside the work. These activities will not close any travel lanes. Crews will fully reopen the sidewalk by 3 p.m. on Thursday.

The work will create noise, but will not exceed the limits established by the City of Seattle Noise Ordinance for daytime outside construction activities. When the work is completed, the sidewalk surface will be restored.
