City, County, Ports, Tribal Nations, Transit, WSDOT, MPO and RTPO staff who are responsible for preparing and maintaining their area of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), 6 year Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) and Regional Transportation Improvement Programs (RTIPs).

Course Description

The Federal Transportation Act requires that each state develop a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Federal aid projects must be included in the STIP before Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) can authorize the expenditure of federal funds. This training will provide hands on computer training for the web based STIP database and address any issues or concerns users are having. There will also be a review of the federal requirements for projects included in the STIP and the development schedule for the 2017-2020 STIP.
