### ***Target Audience***

This course is designed for individuals who will be rating the condition of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavements in the field or those who will train their staff in doing the work. Expertise in pavements is not required.

### ***Course Description***

Participants will be provided a practical working knowledge of how to rate the condition of roadway pavements in accordance with the standards of the Northwest Pavement Management Association using the ***Pavement Surface Condition Field Rating Manual for Asphalt Pavement***.

Upon completion of this course, participants should be able to rate any of the asphalt pavements commonly found in Washington. Each participant should be able to perform a pavement condition survey with reasonable objectivity.
