## Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

### Evergreen Point Road park and ride moving to final location

Crews will open a portion of the new park and ride lot at the southeast end of the Evergreen Point Road lid. The lot will replace the 19 stalls currently located on the north side of the lid. It will remain in this configuration until the full 50-stall lot is complete at the end of the project.

#### Park and ride details:

- Saturday, July 27 the temporary Park and ride lot at the northwest corner of Evergreen Point Road permanently closes and the new lot opens in the final location at the southeast end of the Evergreen Point Road lid.
- A minimum of 19 parking stalls will be made available during construction.
- The final lot will have 50 parking stalls.
- The pedestrian paths to the westbound and eastbound transit stops will remain in the same location until the new median transit stop is completed.

- Drivers should plan to use the new lot at the southeast end of Evergreen Point Road beginning Saturday, July 27.
- If the Evergreen Point Road lot is full, drivers can use the Talon park and ride located at 10700 Northrup Way.
