Changes coming to Northeast Points Drive


Wall construction, local pedestrian and bicycle path to be complete this fall

Eastside Corridor Constructor crews are completing major construction activities this fall including the corridor walls, the local bicycle and pedestrian path and reopening Northeast Points Drive. Residents will have full use of the paved local trail between 92nd Avenue Northeast and Bellevue Way and drivers can expect the original roadway access to be back in place this fall.

Timeline of upcoming work *(tentative and subject to change)*

Sept. 2013:	Complete retaining wall, open Northeast Points Drive and paved local trail
Oct. 2013:	Install gate and planting barrier
Winter 2013/Spring 2014:	Landscaping and miscellaneous items
Spring 2014:	Open regional trail

What residents and drivers need to know



Residents and drivers

- Emergency vehicles will be the only vehicle traffic allowed through the gate from either side.
- Points Drive Northeast residents west of the gate will access their homes via 92nd Avenue Northeast.
- Northeast Points Drive residents east of the gate, including those on 96th Avenue Northeast, will access their homes via Bellevue Way.

What bicycles and pedestrians need to know



Bicycles and pedestrians

- The local bicycle and pedestrian path along Northeast Points Drive will open this fall and users will be able to travel between 92nd Avenue Northeast to Bellevue Way on this paved trail.
- Following project completion, crews will open the regional trail which will be located on the north side of SR 520 between Bellevue Way and Evergreen Point Road. Users will access the regional trail at Evergreen Point Road, 84th and 92nd avenues northeast and Bellevue Way.

ECC crews will plant a mix of shrubs such as Woods' Compact Kinnikinnick and Autumn Joy Sedum next to the Ashlar Stone wall along Northeast Points Drive.

Crews will complete utility installation and wall construction on the west end of Northeast Points Drive. Note: the regional trail is shown on the left side of the picture.
