# Ordinance No. 491

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EVERSON, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS STANDARDS PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 47.50 RCW IN CHAPTERS 468-51 AND 468-52 WAC BY REFERENCE, AND ADDING CHAPTER 12.16 TO THE EVERSON MUNICIPAL CODE.

**Whereas**, pursuant to RCW 47.50.020(3) and 47.50.040, the City of Everson is the permitting authority regulating access regulating access to state highways within its incorporated area, namely State Route 544 which traverses the City as portions of Everson Goshen Road, Mead Avenue, Kale Street, Everson Road and Main Street;

**Whereas**, the City of Everson required by RCW 47.50.030(3) to adopt standards which meet or exceed, but are not inconsistent with, Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) standards for access permitting on streets designated as state highways;

**Whereas**, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has, pursuant to Chapter 47.50 RCW, adopted for state highway access management an *Access Control Classification System and Standards* in Chapter 468-52 WAC and an *Administrative Process* for access permits in Chapter 468-51 WAC;

**Whereas**, the City Council finds no necessity for providing for other or further access management standards than those adopted by WSDOT; that adoption of WSDOT's standards by reference is in the best interests of the City of Everson, and that adopting the WSDOT access permit system for City use promotes uniformity of practice; **Now Therefore**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVERSON, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** There is hereby added to the Everson Municipal Code a new chapter, Chapter 12.16 *State Highway Access Management*, the three sections of which shall read as follows:

**12.16.010 State Highway Access Management; Purpose.** This Chapter is intended to adopt standards for access permitting on streets designated as state highways, consistent with standards adopted by the Washington State Department of Transportation, as required by RCW 47.50.030(3), and to implement a City access permit and administrative process in uniformity with the state access permit and administrative process.

**12.16.020 State Highway Access Management; State Access Control Classification System and Standards Adopted.** The City of Everson adopts by reference the Washington State Department of

Transportation *Highway Access Management - Access Control Classification System and Standards*, promulgated as Chapter 468-52 WAC under authority of Chapter 47.50 RCW, including all future amendments or additions thereto.

**21.16.030 State Highway Access Management; State Access Permit and Administrative Process Adopted.**

A. The City of Everson adopts by reference the Washington State Department of Transportation *Highway Access Management Access Permits - Administrative Process*, promulgated as Chapter 468-51 WAC under authority of RCW 47.50, including all future amendments or additions thereto.

B. Each reference to "the department" or "department" in Chapter 468-51 in its role as the permitting authority shall be deemed to refer to the City of Everson.

C. The City official(s) responsible for administration of the access permit program shall be the Building Official in consultation with the Public Works Director.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to authenticate and attach copies of said laws adopted by reference to this Ordinance and to maintain not less than one (1) copy thereof on file for public use and examination during regular City business hours.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, separately and independently and, in the event that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases may later be declared invalid or unconstitutional, then any ordinance or ordinances, or parts thereof, amended or repealed by such portion this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from after five (5) days after passage, approval, signing, and publication/posting, as provided by law.


