

Instructions to Access the WSDOT Cultural Resources Project Consultation (CRPC) Sites



Step 1 - create an account with Secure Access Washington


Go to Secure Access Washington (SAW) (<https://secureaccess.wa.gov>) and follow the instructions for creating an account. If you already have an account with SAW you can skip this step. [Learn more about SAW.](#)

Step 2 - requesting access to the WSDOT Cultural Resources Project Consultation sites, an iPRMT service

Sign-in to [Secure Access Washington](#). After you are in, make sure you are on the "Add a New Service" tab.



Once you are on the "Add a New Service" tab look for the "Service code" field. Enter **iprmt24** in the Service code field and click the "Apply" button.



Instructions to Access the WSDOT Cultural Resources Project Consultation (CRPC) Sites

You should automatically be granted access and this service will appear under the “My Services” tab. Log out of SAW. You only need to do this once to set up your account in SAW and gain access to the WSDOT CRPC sites.

Step 3 – opening a WSDOT CRPC site

A list of active CRPC sites for transportation projects are available on the WSDOT Cultural Resource Program, [Section 106 Consultation](#) website. Select a project, log in with your SAW account and you will automatically be directed to the CRPC site.

Closing a SAW Account

To disable your SAW account (and access to the WSDOT CRPC sites) log into SAW and select Account Management. Click on the Cancel My SAW Account tab and follow the instructions. Your access to SAW and the CRPC sites will be disabled. To regain access you will need to follow steps 1-3 above to register a new SAW account.
