



SR 9 Construction: Weekend Closure South of Maltby Road

State Route 9 is the only major north-south roadway on the east side of Snohomish County and the only major alternative to Interstate 5. As the population of Snohomish County has boomed in recent years, so have traffic volumes on area roadways. The increase in traffic has transformed SR 9 from a free-flowing rural corridor into a gridlocked highway filled with commuters.

WSDOT is currently working to improve SR 9 between SR 522 and 212th Street SE.

The **SR 9: SR 522 to 212th Street SE Project** will:

- widen two miles of SR 9 from a two lane road to a four lane divided highway between SR 522 north of Woodinville to just north of SR 524 (Maltby Road)
- add right and left-turn lanes and sidewalks at key intersections
- add a raised median on SR 9, with designated turn pockets and u-turns at signals to provide access to businesses

Widening SR 9 and improving intersections will relieve traffic congestion and improve traffic flow and safety for the 33,000 drivers who use the highway each day.


ROADWAY CLOSURE AND DETOUR

WSDOT and Wilder Construction crews will completely close SR 9 between 228th Street SE and SR 524 (Maltby Road) the weekend of September 29 while they install a new culvert at Cutthroat Creek, just south of the intersection of SR 9 and Maltby Road.

- The road will be closed to through traffic from 10 p.m. on Friday, September 29 to 5 a.m. on Monday, October 2. Local access will be allowed.
- A detour route utilizing SR 9, 228th St. SE, 39th Avenue SE, Maltby Road and SR 522 will be provided.
