Dear Property Owner, Business Proprietor or Resident:

Next week, crews working for WSDOT will inspect a storm drain and sewer pipe beneath South Royal Brougham Way with a video camera. In order to complete this work, crews will temporarily close two lanes on South Royal Brougham Way.

**What you can expect**

Crews will work on and underneath South Royal Brougham Way on Tuesday, May 27 and Wednesday, May 28 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. In order to complete this work, crews will temporarily close the eastbound and westbound center lanes between Occidental Avenue South and Fourth Avenue South. The remaining eastbound and westbound lanes will stay open to traffic during the work. The closed lanes will reopen by 3 p.m. each day.

The work may create noise, but will not exceed the limits established by the City of Seattle Noise Ordinance for daytime and nighttime outside construction activities.
