Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

84th Ave NE on-ramp to westbound SR 520 opens in temporary configuration

Existing loop ramp closes to make room for the roundabout structure


On Wednesday, Aug. 21, crews will open a new 84th Avenue Northeast on-ramp to westbound SR 520 from 84th Avenue Northeast. The on-ramp, which opens in its final location, will be served by a temporary intersection while a roundabout is built on top of the lid.

During this configuration:

- There will be no stop for drivers headed south on 84th Avenue Northeast out of Hunts Point.
- There will be no stop for drivers headed north on 84th Avenue Northeast into Hunts Point.
- Northbound drivers turning left onto westbound SR 520 will yield to southbound drivers on 84th Avenue Northeast.

Next steps:

Closing the loop ramp makes room for crews to build the future roundabout structure, shown in gray on the graphic.
