Dear Property Owner, Business or Resident:

Crews working for WSDOT will repave potholes created by geotechnical work in the SR 519 project area between March 3 and March 5. This minor road repaving will take place on the eastbound travel lanes of South Royal Brougham Way.

**What You Can Expect**

Crews will repave Monday through Wednesday from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. They will close the left eastbound lane and then the right eastbound lane of South Royal Brougham Way. Approximately 200-foot sections will be blocked between Occidental Avenue South and Fourth Avenue South at each repaving location. Crews will reopen all lanes to traffic by 3 p.m. daily.

The work will create noise, but will not exceed the limits established by the City of Seattle Noise Ordinance for daytime outside construction activities.
