



We are working to reduce delays at the Lakemont Boulevard and West Lake Sammamish Parkway roundabout

We recently rebuilt the roundabout at West Lake Sammamish Parkway and Lakemont Boulevard near I-90 in an attempt to reduce traffic backups and delay. As you know, our construction didn't deliver the results we expected. Eliminating the right turn lane connecting westbound Lake Sammamish Parkway to northbound West Lake Sammamish Parkway created backups that weren't projected by our traffic analysis and computer simulations.

We know the traffic delays are frustrating and regret that congestion is making you late for work, school or other important activities. These backups are unacceptable and we are taking steps to fix the problem.

WHAT ARE WE DOING TO FIX THE PROBLEM?

Now: Starting this week, we will direct traffic through the roundabout during morning rush hours. This will reduce backups on Lake Sammamish Parkway.

In addition, our traffic engineers have been working to develop other quick-fix options to reduce delays. They are assessing whether changing traffic signal timing, changing striping on the pavement or other options could alleviate congestion.

Long term: WSDOT designers are considering ways to build a new right turn lane directly connecting westbound Lake Sammamish Parkway to northbound West Lake Sammamish Parkway. We do not yet have a timeline or funding for this project.
