

## NOTICE: 92nd Avenue Northeast Flyer Stop Closing Aug. 4

Beginning Aug. 4, the eastbound SR 520 92nd Avenue Northeast flyer stop will be closed for construction. The closure will continue until the new 92nd Avenue Northeast transit stop opens in the SR 520 median, scheduled for the end of 2013. The westbound 92nd Avenue Northeast flyer stop will remain open.

King County Metro Route 260 will serve eastbound riders at a temporary stop on Points Drive Northeast just west of 92nd Avenue Northeast. All other regular eastbound Metro and Sound Transit routes can be accessed at the Evergreen Point Road flyer stop.


A free shuttle provides service to transit riders between Evergreen Point Road and 92nd Avenue NE, from 6:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

When school starts in the fall, eastbound Lakeside School Routes 982, 986 and 992 will stop at the temporary stop on Points Drive Northeast just west of 92nd Avenue Northeast.
