

Tree removal in Bothell starts week of June 10

Construction crews working on the I-405 – Bellevue to Lynnwood Widening and Express Toll Lanes Project will begin removing trees and shrubs as early as Monday, June 10 on the west side of I-405 north of NE 195th Street in Bothell. Tree removal is needed to build a new noise wall for residents located on 112th Avenue NE.

Temporary traffic changes on 112th Avenue NE

The majority of tree removal work will take place on 112th Avenue NE, which will require a portion of the roadway to be closed to traffic. However, traffic will be maintained in both directions. Drivers should expect to see construction equipment, cones, barrels and flaggers on-site to assist with traffic control.

Construction noise

In an effort to balance the varying needs of commuters and residents, and to ensure safety and efficiency for our crews, tree removal work will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours.

Crews will work to keep noise and other disruptions to a minimum. However, neighbors can expect noise from equipment used to cut down, remove, chip and/or haul away trees and vegetation.

Future noise wall construction

Construction of the new noise wall is expected to begin later this year. We will be in touch with you again as this work approaches.
