Join us at Seattle Center to discover how WSDOT and the City of Seattle are working together to transform the downtown waterfront.

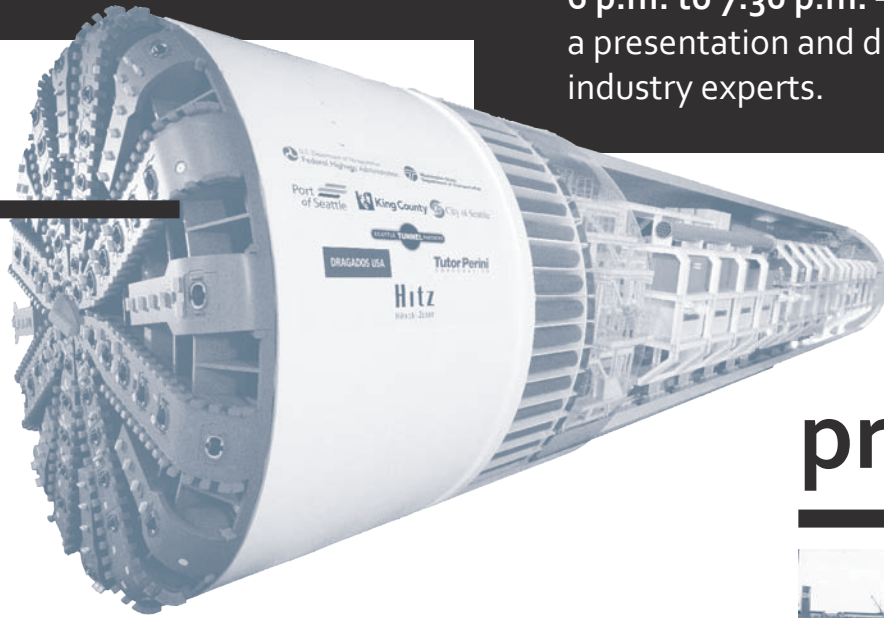
