



SR 520 Bridge Replacement and HOV Program



I-5 to Medina: Bridge Replacement and HOV Project

Crews to place anchors in Lake Washington near Seattle for the new bridge ***Work begins week of July 16 and continues through the fall***

WSDOT and its contractor, Kiewit/General/Manson, a Joint Venture (KGM), will begin vibratory installation of large shaft anchors that will secure and stabilize the new SR 520 floating bridge. Barge cranes will sink large casings into the lake bed and then fill them with concrete to form bridge anchors. The anchor shaft work will be performed north and south of the existing bridge, about 500-700 feet from the shore. Crews will also install pilings that will be the foundations for columns for the new SR 520 bridge being built just north of the existing bridge.

Crews will work Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and occasionally Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. to complete the work. Work after 5 p.m. and on Saturdays will be covered by a City of Seattle temporary noise variance. Concrete pours may extend past 10 p.m. and into the early morning hours for up to ten nights throughout the work duration. Residents near the floating bridge should expect to see large crane barges and other support vessels when crews perform the work. Concrete trucks and pumps will be on the barges supplying materials for the anchors and pilings. Residents may hear noise from generators, cranes, power and vibratory equipment, concrete pumps, motors and backup equipment. WSDOT and KGM will ensure this work, which could last until October, does not exceed allowable decibel levels.
