Dear Applicant:

This Letter of Limited Agent Status constitutes a formal acceptance by the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) of the "Application and Agreement for Limited Agent Status for Aquatic Noxious Weed Control under WSDA's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit" (hereinafter, "Application for Limited Agent Status") submitted by the above-named entity.

As set forth in the Application for Limited Agent Status and agreed to in this Letter of Limited Agent Status, WSDA hereby enters into a contract with the above-named entity (Section I), under which the entity acts as a limited agent to carry out noxious aquatic and quarantine weed control for WSDA under the "Aquatic Noxious Weed Control National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Waste Discharge General Permit" (hereinafter, "Permit") issued to WSDA on February 16, 2008.



This coverage applies to only the noxious weed control and/or eradication activities described in the Application for Limited Agent Status (Section II). This coverage terminates December 31, 2011, and is subject to fish-timing windows and any other timing constraints agreed to in the Application for Limited Agent Status or imposed under the Permit. Any noxious weed control and/or eradication activities that are not completed by December 31, 2011, may not continue beyond that date until a new Application of Limited Agent Status is submitted and a Letter of Limited Agent Status issued in response.

The above-named entity agrees to comply with all terms, conditions, and requirements included or referenced in the Application for Limited Agent Status, Permit and appropriate state, federal and local laws. WSDA issues this Letter of Limited Agent Status in specific reliance on the representations and agreements made by the entity in the Application for Limited Agent Status and WSDA intends that the entity comply with all terms, conditions, and requirements included or referenced in the Application for Limited Agent Status and the Permit.



The entity is notified hereby that, under a federal court decision, pesticide applicators must comply with the buffer requirement provisions for 2,4-D applications in or near salmon-supporting waters.
