



Weekend lane restrictions on I-90 east of Snoqualmie Summit

Drivers should plan for additional travel time Friday through Sunday

SNOQUALMIE PASS – As WSDOT and crews continue working around the clock to complete the first phase of a concrete preservation project on I-90 from Easton (milepost 70) near Cle Elum (milepost 80) before the first snowfall, weekend travelers of I-90 may experience up to two hours of additional travel time during their trip.

Lane restrictions: From Friday, Sept. 25 at 9 a.m. until Sunday, Sept. 27 at 9 a.m., two travel lanes will be open in the eastbound direction, with one lane open in the westbound direction.

- On Friday and Saturday, eastbound travelers will experience moderate congestion and some added travel time.
- On Friday and Saturday, westbound travelers may experience heavy congestion and up to two hours of additional travel time between 2 p.m. and 10 p.m.

Early Sunday morning, to accommodate the reverse commute, two travel lanes will be open in the westbound direction, with one lane open in the eastbound direction.

- Westbound travelers will experience moderate congestion and some added travel time, particularly between the hours of 5 p.m. and 6 p.m. when traffic volumes reach their peak.
- Eastbound travelers may experience heavy congestion and up to two hours of additional travel time between noon and 9 p.m.

WSDOT appreciates driver's patience as we work to make I-90 safer and more reliable and asks drivers to pay attention to signage through the construction work zones and maintain the posted speed limit of 50 mph. To reduce the time spent waiting in line, WSDOT encourages drivers to use both lanes up to the merge point, then alternate vehicles from both lanes into the single lane through the work zone.

While on the road, drivers can tune into the Highway Advisory Radio at 1610 AM and 530 AM and dial 5-1-1 from their hands-free device for current conditions.

Interchange restrictions: Motorists are also advised the westbound on-ramp at Golf Course Road interchange (Exit 78) and the westbound on-ramp and off-ramp at West Nelson interchange (Exit 74) are closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week until Nov. 5.

Width Restrictions: Freight drivers should be aware that there is a width restriction for loads over 12 feet wide is in place 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
