Nearby property owners attend community open house

Property owners closest to the three proposed noise walls on the west side of I-5 attended a community [open house](#) on May 31, 2007 to discuss the proposed noise wall locations, heights, anticipated noise level reductions, and the community polling process. We answered questions and received comments from the public about noise wall locations, heights and how construction of these noise walls may affect landscaping near the proposed wall location.

WSDOT launches neighborhood poll in Green Lake and Licton Springs neighborhoods

We are currently facilitating a community poll of property owners within 500 feet of the edge of the traveled freeway lane. The community poll is one of many sources of public input that WSDOT receives before continuing with design and construction of three proposed noise walls on the west side of I-5. Other sources include correspondence with individual property owners, local community organizations, elected officials, and community meetings. A separate poll is being conducted for each of the three proposed noise walls.

There will be a two-week feedback period (June 11 – 25, 2007) for submitting completed ballots. Throughout this two-week period, completed polling ballots will be tallied and summarized. You can [track polling results](#) during the polling period.

Stay tuned for results in July

We will use the results from the poll, in combination with the feedback we have received from nearby property owners, elected officials, community council briefings and the May 31 community open house, to determine whether to proceed with design and construction of these proposed walls. We will send a letter to all project contacts summarizing the feedback we've received and next steps. We will also provide updates at community council briefings in July.
