[Starting July 1, talking on a cell phone while driving will be illegal without a headset or hands-free device](#). While you can't be pulled over if seen talking on your cell, you can still be cited and fined \$124 for using your cell while driving during other traffic violation stops. You can still use your cell phone if you use a hands-free device such as a Bluetooth, wired headset, or speaker phone.
