ORDINANCE #320

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR HIGHWAY ACCESS MANAGEMENT, ACCESS PERMITS, AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS PURSUANT TO RCW 47.50

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REARDAN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

This Ordinance is adopted to implement Chapter 47.50 RCW (copy attached) for the regulation and control of vehicular access and connection points of ingress to, and egress from, the state highway system within the incorporated areas of Reardan.

SECTION II

Pursuant to the requirements and authority of RCW 47.50, there is hereby adopted by reference the provisions of Chapter 468-51 (copy attached) and Chapter 468-52 (copy attached) of the Washington Administrative Code, together with all future amendments, in order to implement the requirements of Chapter 47.50 RCW.

ORDINANCE 4320

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR HIGHWAY ACCESS MANAGEMENT
ACCESS PERMITS AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS PERTAINING TO
ROW 43.50

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF
REARICK, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION I

This Ordinance is added to, amended, Chapter 43.50, R.O.W. 43.50
to read in full as follows: "The purpose of this Ordinance is to
provide uniformity and clarity in the application of the
right-of-way rules of the town."
