I-405 construction today means faster, safer travel tomorrow



The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is building a series of major improvements to I-405 through Kirkland. Construction will continue through 2009. During construction, drivers will experience significant increases in traffic congestion.

To keep you moving during construction, WSDOT and King County Metro Transit have invested in new bus service, Park & Ride expansions, ridesharing incentives, and real-time traffic information. This mailer contains everything you need to plan your commute:



Kirkland Area Project

Construction is underway at Totem Lake Freeway Station at NE 128th Street. Work has also begun on the Kirkland Nickel Improvement Project, to widen lanes between NE 85th Street and NE 116th Street, and to reconfigure the NE 116th Street interchange.





Keep moving with new services and traffic information

The Washington State Department of Transportation and King County Metro Transit are providing expanded services to keep you moving, and traffic information so you'll **know before you go**:



Ride the bus on us

We've enclosed free bus tickets, added new service from Kenmore to Overlake (Route 644), and extended service on Route 255 to Brickyard Park & Ride.



Bike and ride

Bike to a Park & Ride lot and take the bus. Park & Ride lots have plenty of bike parking, and all Metro and Sound Transit buses have easy-to-use bike racks.



Bridge the gap between home-transit-work

Metro VanShare provides commuter groups of three or more with a van and reserved parking at Park & Ride lots, to connect from home to the bus or from the bus to work. As added incentives, we'll waive your VanShare fees for the first year and each new group will receive a **\$100 MasterCard gift card** to buy gas.



Beat backups by using carpool lanes

Find or form a carpool, VanPool, or VanShare at RideshareOnline.com. Metro will even provide a van, maintenance, insurance, and fuel for **one low monthly fee**.



Know before you go with real-time traffic information

WSDOT's online Traffic Flow Maps give you up-to-the minute traffic information. You can also get real-time traffic information on your wireless handheld device.



Get traffic updates on the road

While on the road, look for electronic traffic information signs with current travel times and incident information. You can also tune your radio to AM 530 or call 511.
