About this project

WSDOT plans to build a new flyover ramp connecting the express toll lanes on SR 167 with carpool lanes on I-405 in Renton. This new ramp will improve traffic flow and safety at this heavily traveled interchange (*see visualization at right*).

WSDOT has not yet received construction funding and would not break ground until at least 2015. However, we recently received funding to complete our preliminary engineering and to purchase the property we need to construct the project.
