

On August 3, 2009 the prevailing wage division of Labor & Industries published wage rate changes that were to become effective September 2, 2009. These changes encompassed survey results for the following 22 trades:

These 22 trades represent roughly 1/3 of all of the existing prevailed wage rates. As a result of the significant changes to these trades a number of stakeholders have requested, and L&I has granted, a six (6) month delay in the publication of the results. This time will allow L&I to review stakeholder input and ensure the accuracy of the results.

The purpose of this email is to make you aware of this change. On Monday August 24, 2009 a new wage set will be published with the effect of the survey being removed from the 22 trades above. All remaining rates will be unchanged from the previous publication. All rates published on August 24, 2009 will be effective September 2, 2009.
