

APPENDIX D CHARACTERISTICS OF NON-VEHICLE MODE USERS—CORRIDOR LEVEL FINDINGS

This section presents characteristics of non-vehicle mode users for each of the four corridors. “Transit” is defined as survey respondents who accessed, egressed, or both accessed and egressed the terminal using transit. “Walk” is defined as survey respondents who accessed or egressed, or both accessed and egressed the terminal on foot.



San Juan Islands Corridor

Weekday and Saturday ferry riders who used transit to access or egress the ferry terminal in the San Juan Islands Corridor account for 3% and 2% of survey period ridership, respectively. Weekday and Saturday ferry riders who walked to access or egress the ferry terminal in the San Juan Islands Corridor account for 8% and 10% of survey period ridership, respectively.








North Sound (Whidbey Island) Corridor






Central Sound Corridor



South Sound Corridor
