EVIDENCE OF LEARNING



LAND RESTORATION / REVEGETATION

Plant roots hold soil together, keeping stream banks from washing out; they filter the water, so clean water runs into lakes, ponds, and rivers.



ANIMAL CROSSINGS

The Washington State Department of Transportation helps wildlife cross the highway safely.

Drivers and wildlife will be safer, because fewer animals will be on the road.



TURBIDITY

Turbidity is a measure of the murkiness of water. Turbidity makes it difficult for plants to grow and for animals to see.

Lakes, ponds and rivers need clear water and coarse sediment for fish habitat.
